Participant Expectations – Adults

This Saint Nicholas event is an intentional Christian community. In such a community the behavior of all participants reflects the faith we share in Jesus Christ our Lord. This covenant is a promise you make with the community.

Therefore, it is expected that

1. If you are planning on arriving late or leaving the event early you will tell the lead chaperone of the event before the event begins. For reasons of safety and accountability, participants who arrive late will check in with the designated event leader, and will not leave the venue without checking out with the designated event leader.
2. For reasons of safety and accountability, participants will not leave the venue.
3. All registrants - both youth and adults - will participate fully in all activities at the event.
4. If this is an overnight event (other than a lock-in), participants are expected to return to and remain in their rooms at lights out, respecting the need for quiet rest.
5. Participants are expected to respect the property of others and of the event site, to clean up after themselves, and if responsible for loss or damage, to pay for it.
6. Absolutely no alcohol, weapons, tobacco, or drugs (other than prescribed medication) will be brought to or used at the event.
7. Cell phones will only be used during free time unless there is an emergency.
8. A background check will be completed by the church on all adult chaperones.
9. Adults are not to be alone with only one youth.
10. Saint Nicholas Lutheran Church will be proud of the way in which our community represented them.

By my signature, I agree to abide by, support and help enforce these expectations, and I acknowledge that I am primarily responsible for the conscientious participation of the youth I accompany, their regard for others through the acceptance of guidelines established for the event, including curfew, and their physical well-being. Participant Expectations – Youth

4. If you need to use the restroom at a venue off-site of Saint Nicholas, please ask someone to go with you and tell a chaperone. If someone asks you to go with them, please go along unless you have a good reason. (Buddy system)
5. If this is an overnight (other than a lock-in), participants are expected to return to and remain in their rooms at lights out, respecting the need for quiet rest.
6. Participants are expected to respect the property of others and of the event site, to clean up after themselves, and if responsible for loss or damage, to pay for it.
7. Absolutely no alcohol, weapons, tobacco, or drugs (other than prescribed medication which should be given to a chaperone unless your parent is attending the event) will be brought to or used at the event.
8. iPods, electronic games, and cell phones may be brought to the event. They are only to be used during free time, not during scheduled activities.
9. Saint Nicholas will be proud of the way in which our community represented them.

In the event that anyone breaks the covenant, we will address it immediately by (depending on the circumstances): holding a group discussion, calling parents, dealing with the problem in private, or sending someone home at the parents' expense.
